Subject: Declaration of Result of Combined Graduate Level Examination (Tier-I), 2020.

The Staff Selection Commission conducted the Combined Graduate Level Examination (Tier-I), 2020 from 13-08-2021 to 24-08-2021 in the Computer Based Mode.

- 2. Based on marks scored in Tier-I Examination, candidates have been shortlisted, category-wise, to appear in Tier-II and Tier-III examinations. Separate cut-offs have been fixed for the posts of Assistant Audit Officer and Assistant Accounts Officer (List-1), Junior Statistical Officer (JSO) (List-2) and all other posts (List-3).
- 3. As the Tier-I Computer Based Examination was conducted in multiple shifts, marks scored by the candidates have been normalized as per the formula published by the Commission on its website on 07-02-2019. Such normalized marks have been used to qualify candidates for the next stages of the Examination (i.e. Tier-II and Tier-III).
- Three candidates (six records) were found to have appeared in Tier I examination twice. Therefore, as per Para 22 of the Notice of the Examination, the candidature of these candidates has been cancelled. Roll Numbers of these three candidates are as follows: -
